

Minutes of the Meeting of Worksoop Charter Trustees held on 18th June 2018.

Phil asked if a big screen TV had been suggested this had been discussed at the last meeting he offered to ask BID if they would help and will mention it at their next meeting.

There may be a problem with the availability of the Town Hall as there is a wedding the next day and they have arranged to come in and set up in the rooms we would need, the Chairman passed on an email she had received.

Phil suggested market stalls be put at the top of High Street as there have been massive problems with road closures for Pride Day.

Councillor Greaves had spoken to Andy Bishop who is willing to put up a display he brought a roadshow bus last year. Councillor Brett had advised the chairman that he had sorted the catering.

Jane asked about promoting local properties including Mr Straw's house. It would be nice to do heritage with the children. Councillor Greaves explained about the tunnels underneath the old public houses. Phil suggested a photo competition with pictures of segments of buildings Phil and Jane will discuss this and report back.

The Chairman is doing a booklet for the trail and updating info boards, Mr Straw's house will be written about as well.

Phil suggested bikes be made from pipe cleaners and put in shop windows for children to find and said free parking would help, this is available on a Saturday in the town hall car park.

Councillor Richardson will be contacting both Rotary Clubs, Lions, British Legion, Help the Heroes, Ask Joel, Voluntary Service, WI and BTA as previously agreed.

Insurance will need to be arranged and Phil recommended Protheroes of Derby.
