### **1. Minutes of the Meeting held on 4th September 2017.**

### **2. Audit**

The clerk reported that the external audit has been completed with the same comments as last year which are being addressed.

### **3. Charter Day**

Councillor Greaves suggested we give the Salvation Army, Miners Welfare and Musicality Singers £100 each for the music on Charter Day.

The craft fair income has been banked with a little from teas and coffees. Councillor Fielding suggested that next year we could run a competition with the primary schools for a junior mayor with their incoming taking place on charter day. The problems getting people to the top end of town were also discussed.

Councillor Greaves suggested we commission the council to run the event perhaps commissioning the museum to put on a display. It was agreed for Councillors Fielding and Pressley to meet with Steve Brown and for the clerk to also attend to see if we can move forward.

It was agreed that we need to bring more people in. The National Trust are among organisations who have expressed an interest in attending next year.
